- 9 You may have to leave out some features for certain devices.

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- 10 You have set up the rules for specific devices by setting and modifying the website's CSS.

Step 4. Work on improving images

- 11 Each device can handle images to some extent, so you need to configure that with the website.

- 12 You need to set and modify the websites CSS and code yet again to meet device requirements for various devices.

Step 5. Figure out your layout

- 13 You can either design your layout by yourself, or you can hire someone to do it for you.
