- 2 Click on the second option named as "Video Manager."
- 3 This is where all your videos will be displayed.
- 4 Go all the way down to the bottom of the page.
- 5 Look at the bottom most of the page and look for an option that says, "Send Feedback."

Getting Traffic To Your Links

- 1 Click on Send Feedback.
- 2 A window will open asking for you to write a feedback. Write a brief description of what you want.
- 3 You could write, "Kindly enable non-skippable ads on my channel."
- 4 Click on the arrow and send your feedback to the YouTube team.

- 7 Go onto your channel and click on the option that says "Monetize with ads."
